YMCA Childcare Resource Service:

San Diego County families looking for care can call [1-800-481-2151](tel:1-800-481-2151) to discuss their child care needs with an advisor, who will complete a specialized search to identify the licensed child care options. Advisors will call providers on the family's behalf to see which providers have open slots and may meet their needs best.

Advisors are available Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Families can also conduct online searches themselves by visiting ymcasd.org/childcarereferrals.
